Registration for the 2018-2019 school year for Early Education Programs and Kindergarten, will be as follows:

<u>Monday, January 15</u> – Registration begins for children entering Kindergarten and for children currently attending our EEP and registering for his/her second year of Early Education.

<u>Monday, February 5</u> – Registration begins for children new to Early Education Programs.

Registration forms are on our website and can also be obtained from the school office.

Kindergarten Information:

- *Children must be five years of age on or before December 31 2018.
- *Bring your child's birth certificate when you register. If you do not have a birth certificate the Department of Education requires that you sign a form stating that you will get one. Those forms are available at the school office.
- *Kindergarten programs run Monday through Thursday in either the morning or the afternoon.

Early Education Program Information:

- *Typically developing children must be at least 3 years of age as of September 30 2018.
- *Programming for 4 year olds is 4 half days per week (Monday through Thursday) at \$150.00 per month. (Fees are subject to change.)
- *Programming for 3 year olds is 2 half days per week (Monday through Thursday) at \$75.00 per month. (Fees are subject to change.)
- *The registration fee of \$40.00 is due at registration. (cash or cheque only; sorry the school does not have change) (Fees are subject to change.)
- *Bring your child's birth certificate when you register. If you do not have a birth certificate the Department of Education requires that you sign a form stating that you will get one. Those forms are available at the school office.

Alberta Education does not provide funding for Early Education programs, other than for children who have identified needs. Children who experience difficulties in speech, language, hearing, vision, behaviour, and/or motor skills, who meet Alberta Education

requirements, may access early intervention programming within our early education classrooms as follows:

Children identified with mild/moderate delays must be at least 4 years old by December 31 2018.

Children identified with severe delays must be at least 3 years old by December 31 2018.

A current assessment indicating the child's identified area of need is necessary for program placement. Should a child meet the Alberta Education requirements, as well as the age requirements, they may access programming without monthly fees. Children whose primary language is not English must be 4 years old by December 31 2018 in order to access ESL (English Second Language) supports.
