 A free, engaging, and inspiring developmentally appropriate K-12 content in a one-hour livestream on May 12th, 2022. On the day, you can expect: Ceremony, Cultural performances by Indigenous artists, TikTok influencer, Theland Kicknosway as our Youth Keynote speaker and Words from our co-founders.


 The livestream is on Thursday, May 12 from 11:30AM - 12:30PM. Links to workshops and the livestream will be sent out by your Indigenous Education teacher in advance.


 One of the main initiatives of the movement is the annual Moose Hide Campaign Day, which brings Canadians from coast to coast together to make tangible progress on reconciliation and the creation of a country free of violence against all.
