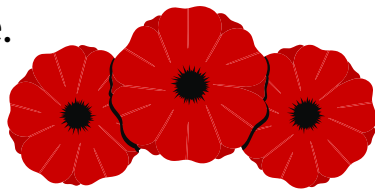

Mike Mountain Horse will be celebrating Roc Your Mocs on November 15th. If you don't have Moccasins, you can wear a turquoise ribbon to show support.

Reminders for Families

We would like to take a minute to remind families of the following:

- School starts at 8:35am. Please try to have students to school on time each day so they don't miss valuable learning opportunities.
- As the weather begins to cool off, please make sure students are dressed for the weather. All students go outside for up to 40 minutes each day. The only time we have indoor recess is if temperatures drop to -20 degrees Celsius.
- If morning temperatures are -20 or below, at 8:30am, students will be allowed to enter the building as they arrive.
- Please keep your child home if they show any symptoms of illness or express they are not feeling well. Students who come to school with symptoms of illness will be sent home.

Student Pick Up and Drop Off

As the weather cools off and more students are getting dropped off and picked up, we would like to remind parents about traffic safety around the school.

- There is NO PARKING in front of the school - this is a bus drop off and pick up zone. We have multiple busses each morning and afternoon and any vehicles stopped in the no parking zone will be asked to move.
- The drop off zone in the north parking lot is a stop and go zone ONLY. Parents are asked NOT to park in this zone. Please pull in, let your kids out or in and pull out as quickly as possible.
- If you must leave your vehicle, please park in the marked parking stalls ONLY. We have had a number of near collisions between vehicles not parked in stalls.
- DO NOT complete U-Turns in front of the school.

Please note the school will continue to contact The Lethbridge Police Service traffic division to patrol the school zones and support the safety of our students.
