- Casino

Wish List

- Society budget is \$46,106.36
 - Prefer to keep a balance of \$20,000 at all times.
 - After iPads (\$6,000), Sound System (\$1,000), Core Board (\$700) and council request there is \$9,377.76 left to spend.
 - Discussion was had where this number came from because the math does not add up?
 - Original wish list from Kerry was \$8,400 for books (\$300 per class), \$1,890 document cameras, \$1,599.92 little spot learning which would put us overspending by \$2,512.16.
 - The council members feel strongly that the money is raised with the expectation to be spent, and school administrators/teachers know what is best for schools and students. No one feels comfortable removing anything from the wish list, nor cutting out spending on classroom allocations for field trips from the school council budget.
 - Motion to vote on approving the purchasing of all items listed on the wish list, cutting into the desired balance buffer of society. – Danica Forsyth
 - Seconded by Sara Prete
 - All in favour 8 Votes
 - All opposed 0 Votes
 - Approved
