#### **Highlights**

- Although below provincial average, we note an increase in access to supports and services, and we continue to seek creative strategies and solutions to support students, staff and families.
- 72% of students indicate they are engaged in their learning. This is an increase from 60% the previous year. This continues to be an area to focus on as we strive to engage ALL students in their learning. This is also above the provincial average.
- Overall percentage of parents, students and staff are satisfied with the overall quality of basic education—higher than the provincial average.

#### **Challenges to Address**

#### Challenges

- Overall percentage of parents, students and staff satisfied with the ease and accessibility of programs for children at risk has
  declined and is an area to focus on
- Although students and parents indicate a high level of agreement that students are safe at school, are learning the importance of caring for others, are learning respect for others and are treated fairly in school, staff indicate that this is an area of concern and has declined significantly. Professional learning to support staff and student growth and development is being implemented.
- We continue to focus on creating a welcoming caring respectful and safe environment for all of our students, families and staff and will continue to support staff in this area.

- Continue with school wide Spirit Assemblies focusing on the Seven Sacred Teachings
- Continue to promote kindness through the use of the BOOST Board recognizing, acknowledging and celebrating actions
  that demonstrate understanding of the Seven Sacred Teachings (Courage, Respect, Humility, Truth, Wisdom, Honesty,
  Love)
- Highlighting division-supported programs (Second Step, Kids in The Know etc.) to increase student and staff understanding of self-regulation strategies, interpersonal interactions, problem solving and social –emotional learning.
- Continue to have student's take ownership and pride in our school through school jobs such as recycling responsibilities, using indoor and outdoor shoes, washing desks and chairs in classrooms, sweeping classroom floors, keeping the playground clean and liter free.

As a school, we would like to extend our learning about citizenship into the community and are currently exploring options for community service projects such as a community clean up (Pitch In), delivering small tokens of appreciation to our community neighbors, and engaging in learning activities that develop citizenship such as participating in the letters of hope campaign, visiting our local first responders with notes of thanks and encouragement, performing at the hospital.
