## Principal's Report: Kerry Taylor

- professional learning\}
- Something staff has been working on for awhile
- Where are the challenging spaces for the school
- School not designed for this many kids, so it's challenging
- and paper issues
- Started with negative as it's how the human brain works
- Igot lists of things that were challenges
- Once that was out of the way, got lists from the staff that really work
- recess
- bathrooms
- Lineups
- Discussion around how \kerry and staff came to where they are at
- Part of staff handbook
- Consistency is important
- Needed to be on the same page across all staff
- Teachers got the draft this past lfriday
- Behaviour expectations and consequences list is shown on the screen in the front of room where kerry explains what consequences are going to be consistent across all staff for recess, lineups and bathrooms
- Recess
- Staff are going to start asking about plans for recess, especially for kids that struggle with recess
- Staff are also initiating play for kids
- Stay within school boundaries
- Lineup quickly and other lineup rules
- Reinforce idea throughout the year
- Staff's job to teach children these things
- Make sure kids are dressed appropriately
- Can't be letting kids back in to get jackets as it takes supervision away from the rest of the kids
- Another issue is not bringing equipment back in
- Walling - stand at a wall for a few minutes, which staff decides
- Walking - more serious and common behaviour - kid walks with supervisor and chats about good behaviour
- Loss of \recess - fighting, kicking, hitting. Kid might loss next recess but only after communicating with the office staff.
- Recess equipment - if you take it out, you bring it back in. consequences if equipment not brought back
- Expectations of adults as well for supervision.
- Kerry explains what these expectations are and how teachers approach issues on the playground
- Staff has responded well to kids who need help on the playground
- No bells for recess, so they have to use whistles.
- Supervisors do a sweep of the playground after recess to make sure all kids have come in
- Kids are always supervised
- Inside, everyone is in supervision at all times
- Ask teachers always have cell phones for emergencies
- Bathrooms
- Lots of kids that like to play in the bathrooms
- Making expected behaviour known to kids
- Use bathroom, wash your hands and go back to class
- Always use grade level bathroom, no matter where they are in the school
- Unsafe behaviour needs to be reported to staff
- If kids are making a mess, they will be cleaning it up with supervision
- There are children with adult supervision for bathroom visits, to keep the child safe
- Staff always on supervision, even if it's no their grade bathroom
- Thinking about doing a \sign in and \sign out for each classroom but haven't always had success with this
- Trying to limit access to bathrooms per classroom, so they are thinking of only having a certain amount of passes per classroom
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- Hallways
- Kids running down halls and hitting doors and walls
- Walking in the hall, keeping body parts to ourselves
- Make good decisions
- You can smile, wave or wink but keep hands to yourself
- Return to beginning - if class isn't behaving, start from the classroom again
- No class should be moving without an adult
- Ensure kids can see their class
- Careful at the corners $\backslash$
- Lining up \behaviour
- Kids don't have spacial awareness
- They stand too close to each other
- Single file
- Voices off to not disturb other classes
- Make space for classmates to join the line
- Join the end of the line, don't push in
- Line leaders or number orders for lines
- Students who struggle usually have a special spot
- Reinforce consistency
- Staff only move their kids when the kids are ready to gol
- Particular language used
- List of to do's, not do not's
- Going in staff handbook, which can be found on the school website
- Parent conversation with \kerry about their child's experiences and if families will get access to the handbooks so they know what the steps are for recess/consequences
- Kerry asks that if kids are coming home and saying their problems haven't been supported, please make sure to reach out to that child's teacher
- Parent's will get a link to the handbook from schoolmessenger and there will be a spot in the \march newsletter
- Parent and Ikerry conversations about what is happening in the school and if things are being communicated to parents
- Please make sure to contact the teachers if you have a concern
- If you feel like you aren't getting enough communication, please reach out to the teacher
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- Finished school and Aberta Assurance survey on friday
- For Grade 4 students
- Don't traditionally have great responses
- Use it to make a plan for the next year
- Assurance \plan is on the website and all schools \have to go this
- Related to division priorities and what we are doing in the school to support that
- Goals, strategies, resources and measures
- Kerry quickly goes through the Assurance Plan on the website, which is displayed at the front of the room on a whiteboard.
- Focus on PBL
- Supporting learning and wellbeing
- Caring environment for all and all cultures
- How are we learning to respect all the diverse cultures in the school
- Assurance data report is also on the website, which is updated every November.
- Orange and yellow mean things need some work
- All of these can be found on the MMH website
- Mostly the school is doing very well but there are areas to work on - Will bring results once they are available
- Sending in early projections for student numbers for next year
- Returning student registration - they are working on it and parents should be receiving registration by end of April.
- Discussion around how new students can register
- Report cards come out Friday
- Starting to track how many people are logging in
- Naming committee meeting on Monday for new school
- Kerry was invited as the new school will have a large impact on this schools population
- Families have been invited
- Vote and make discussions as a committee and then submit to the board
- Ballot vote
- Keep voting until one name is left
- Icelebrations of learning is on March 14th
- Had very engaging conversations about celebrations of learning vs interviews
- Traditionally, MMH has done interviews during the day and in the evening doing celebration of learning
- Is this actually good, if kids are talking at interviews and then doing the celebration?
- Important for kids to celebrate learning
- How effective are the 10-15 minute interviews with parents and kids having to come back the same night to do a celebration of learning?
- Want to give kids opportunity to just celebrate learning
- Open house format - kids dismissed at 11:30am
- 1-4pm and 5-7:30 pm will be the times
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- One school one book
- Surprise for the staff and students

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- Lock down practice with just staff
- Spirit assembly at the end of the month
- Discussion around spirit assemblies and if parents like them as the format has changed
- Discussion around kids knowing why the kids are getting the spirit awards
- Spring break is early this year
