Spring Report Cards



Allergy Awareness

Mike Mountain Horse Elementary School prides itself on being an "Allergy Aware" school. We recognize that there are a number of children in our school with allergies ranging from mild to life threatening. Children with a severe food allergy must not eat even tiny amounts of the food that cause them to have an allergic reaction. A severe allergic reaction can come on quickly and cause death. Even when a child tries to be careful, an accident can happen. A child with a food allergy and their family are responsible for staying safe but need help from other children, parents, and teachers to help reduce the risk of an accidental exposure.

At MMH we ask that all families help reduce the risk of and accidental exposure to a child with an allergy by following these guidelines:

- Teach your child to wash their hands with soap and water before and after eating. This helps food from getting on other things like desks, books and materials. Washing hands is good for everyone; it can also help reduce the spread of colds and flus.
- Teach your child NOT to share their food, drinks or utensils with others.
 Many children love to share non food items instead (e.g. toys, stickers, games).
- Teach your child to keep their food in their lunch kit or in their hands while eating and keep their hands to themselves if they are eating. This also helps food from getting on other materials.
- Ask your child's teacher if there are any allergies in the classroom and do your very best to avoid sending those items to school with your child. Add a complete list of ingredients to any food you send to school for classroom parties or other food-related school events.

Teachers work everyday with students and families to ensure that we provide the safest environment possible for all children. When we work together, we can keep all children safe!
