Green Shirt Day

Green Shirt Day is a day that honours Logan Boulet, a former Lethbridge School Division student. In case you don't know his story, Logan and his Humboldt Broncos hockey team were traveling to a playoff game on April 6, 2018 when their bus was in a tragic crash. A day later, Logan was not able to overcome his injuries but was able to donate organs to make 6 people's lives better. This act inspired a

wave of thousands and thousands of Canadians to register as organ donors and is known as the Logan Boulet Effect. Green Shirt Day builds on this with organ donor awareness, promoting organ donor registration, and having a conversation with your family about organ donation. Mike Mountain Horse staff and students will recognize Green Shirt Day on Monday, April 7, 2025. Students are asked to wear a green shirt to honour the legacy of Logan Boulet.
